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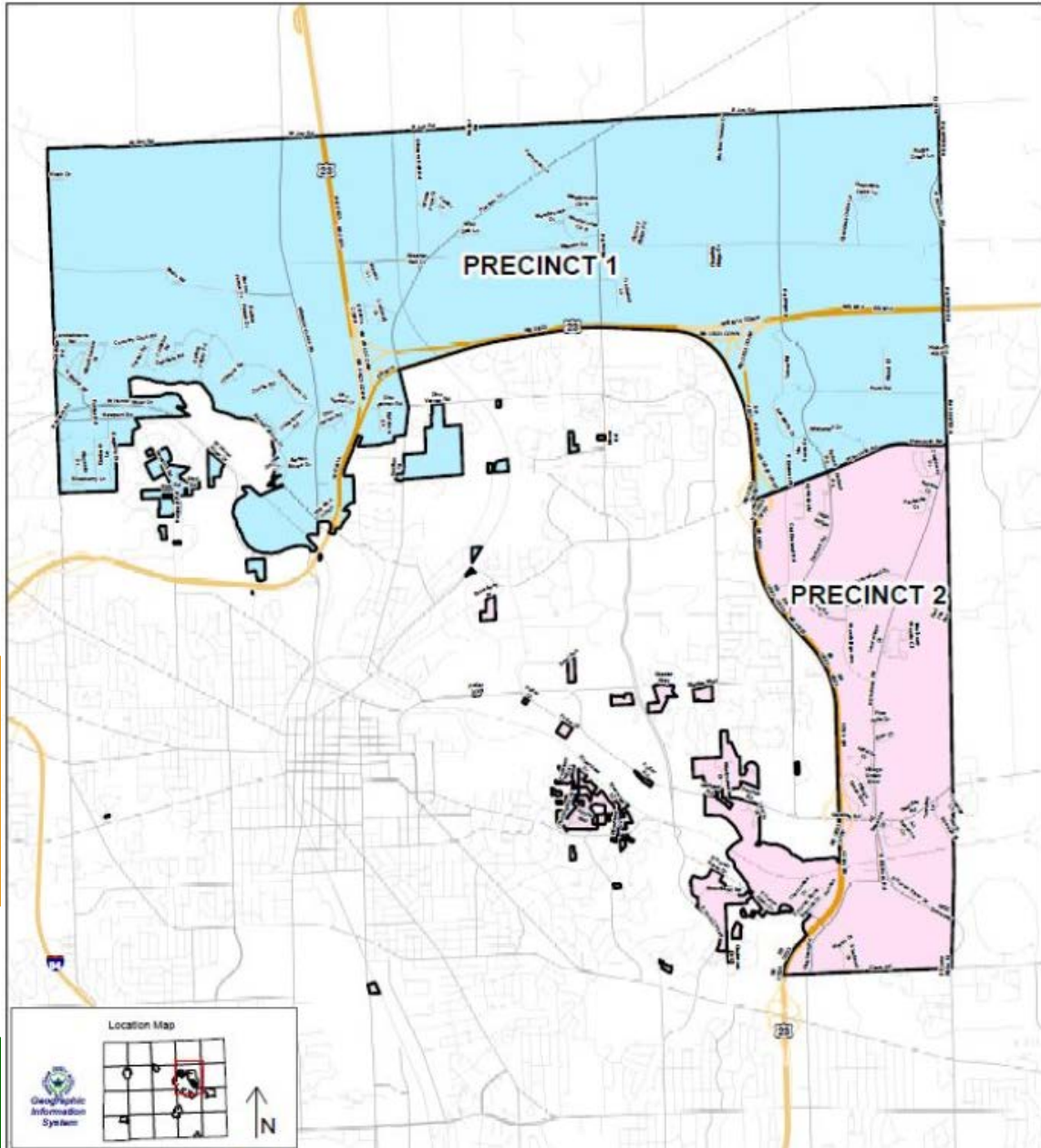

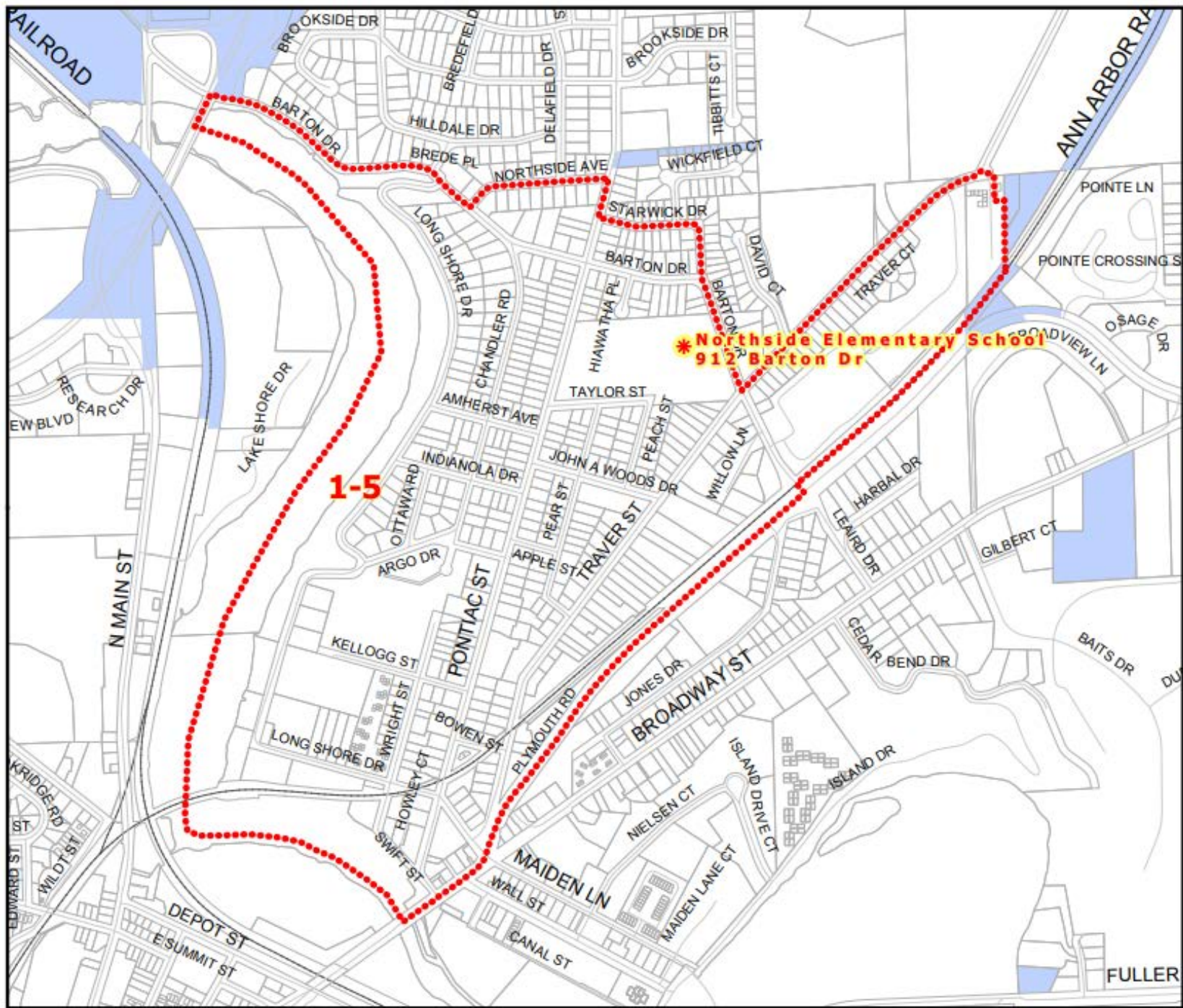

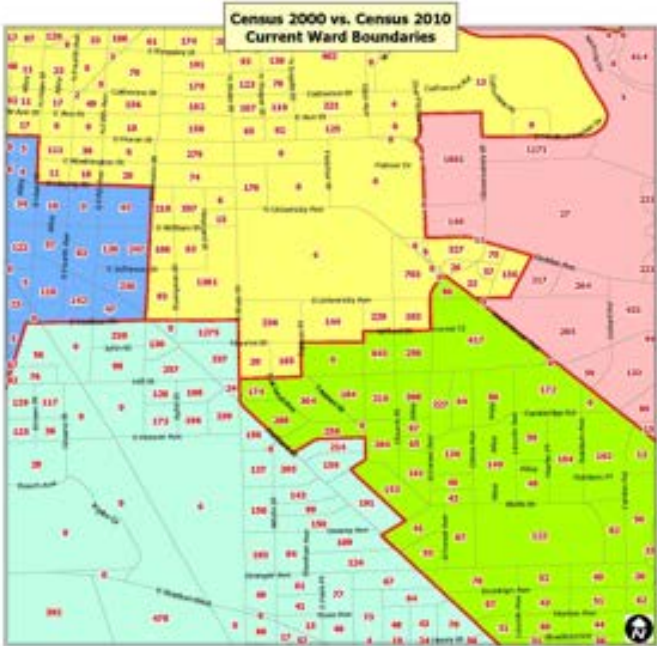

DELTA TOWNSHIP PRECINCTS

PRECINCT 1

- Starting at the northeast township line, west along northern township border to I-96/I-69, south along I-96/I-69 to Willow Hwy., east along the center of Willow Hwy. to Waverly/Grand Ledge School boundary at (Cheltingham, Whitehaven & Attenborough Circle), north to Grand River, follow river east to Waverly Road, north along centerline of Waverly to northeast township line at Millwood and Waverly Road.

PRECINCT 2

- Starting at the northwest township line at Eaton Highway, south on the west township line to Saginaw Hwy., east along the center of Saginaw Hwy. to Canal Road, north along the center of Canal Road to Willow Hwy., west along the center of Willow Hwy. to I-96/I-69, north along I-96/I-69 to the north township line, west along north township boundary to northwest township line at Eaton Hwy.

PRECINCT 3

- Starting at the southeast corner of Canal and Willow Hwy., south along the center of Canal Road to Saginaw Hwy., east along center of Saginaw Hwy., to Carrier Creek, creek north to Willow Hwy., west on center of Willow Hwy., to southeast corner of Canal and Willow Hwy.

PRECINCT 4

- Just east of Garfield Avenue north to just south of Cabrena Drive, east just south of Cabrena Drive to a point between Riley Ridge Dr. and Sand Point Dr., north to Willow Hwy., east along center of Willow Hwy., to Carrier Creek, carrier creek south to Saginaw Hwy., along center of road east to just of Garfield Road.

PRECINCT 5

- Just east of Garfield Avenue north to just south of Cabrena Drive, east just south of Cabrena Drive to a point between Riley Ridge Drive and Sand Point Drive., north to Willow Hwy., east along center of Willow Hwy., to near Grand Woods Park, Willow turns south, continue along center of Willow Hwy., south to Arden Road, follow Arden Road west along center of road to Maycroft Road, continue along center of Maycroft Road south to Saginaw Hwy., follow center of Saginaw Hwy., west to just east of Garfield Road.

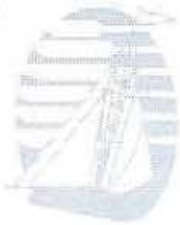

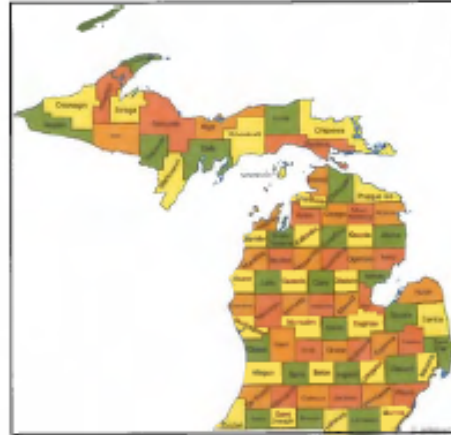

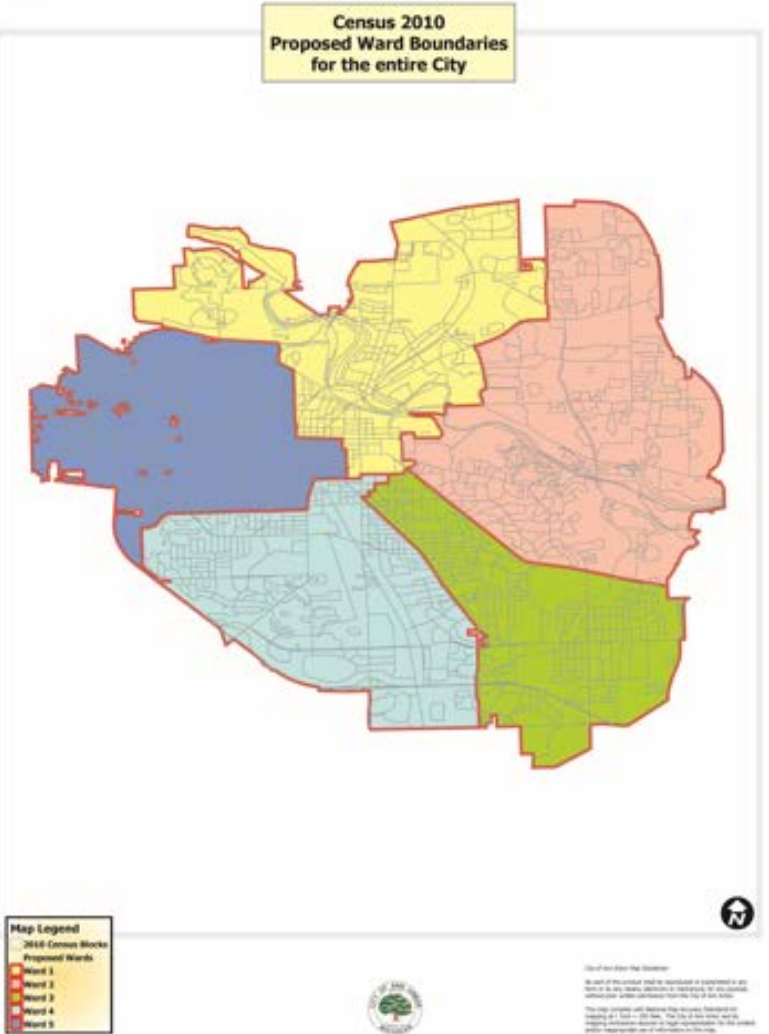

- Precinct boundary changes approved by City Election Commission – adjustments made based upon new ward boundaries and County Commission and State House districts
- All affected voters receive new voter ID card with updated districts and polling place location
