

## **Township – Adam Wit – Harrison Township**

**Adam Wit** has served Harrison Township since 2004, beginning as Deputy Supervisor before being elected Township Clerk in 2012. Prior to his election, he worked in the Clerk’s Office assisting with absentee ballot processing during elections, building a strong operational foundation that has shaped his career.

Throughout his tenure, Adam has demonstrated exceptional leadership within the profession. He served on the Macomb County Clerk Association Board, including as President (2015–2016), and rose through leadership in the Michigan Association of Municipal Clerks (MAMC), ultimately serving as President. He continues to serve on MAMC’s Legislative and CEO Committees. Nationally, he is an active member of the International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC) and holds the prestigious Master Municipal Clerk (MMC) designation, in addition to earning his Michigan Professional Municipal Clerk (MiPMC) certification.

His commitment to excellence has been recognized with numerous honors, including the 2025 Cleary Award for Harrison Township’s innovative “I Voted” sticker initiative and the 2024 MAMC MiExcellence Award. He also participated in the state’s Lean Process Improvement work group for the E-pollbook update and developed a comprehensive election email communication program that provides voters with trusted information and ballot tracking updates.

Adam is deeply committed to advancing and strengthening the clerk profession. He serves as an instructor for MAMC’s “Clerking 101” Bootcamp and teaches courses including “High-Profile Process” and “Election Planning” through Oakland University’s Election Administration Certification Program, where he also serves on the advisory board. As a mentor in the MAMC Clerk-to-Clerk program and a frequent panelist and media resource, he consistently elevates the profession statewide.

Known for prioritizing transparency and accessibility, Adam believes clerks are the front door to local government. Through award-winning communication initiatives, community education efforts, and legislative expertise, he exemplifies the highest standards of municipal service and remains a tireless advocate for election integrity and professional excellence.
